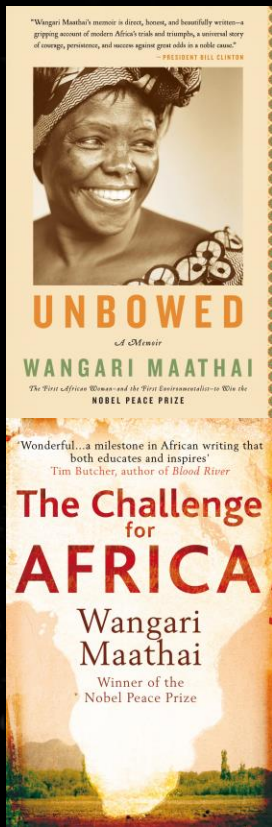




## Dr. Wangari Maathai

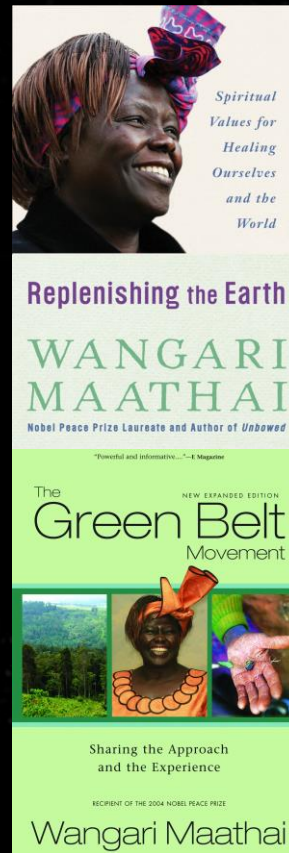
Kenyan environmental activist who was awarded the 2004 Nobel Peace Prize, becoming the first black African woman to win a Nobel Prize. She is also the first woman in either East or Central Africa to earn a Ph.D. She founded the *Green Belt Movement*, which has planted over 51 million trees to combat deforestation and trained community women in trades to maintain independence and promote preservation of natural resources.
